A large cast panel was added after 1945 at low level under its own hood mould, cutting across the plinth.

There has been no expenditure incurred in the current financial year 2005/2006. The trustees have grave concerns regarding the safety aspect of the structure in its current position and have resolved to relocate the structure approximately 10 metres from its current position in line with improvements to the highways, development of a new retail centre and redevelopment to an existing retail centre. This work is estimated to take place during late 2006 at a cost of around £45,000 which will be paid for by way of a 106 planning agreement with the new retail development.
